

Water, Storm, Sewer and Drainage Problems	Report a marijuana grow in a residential area. Gresham does not regulate the smoking of marijuana. The use of marijuana in public or the smell of burning marijuana is not a code violation. To report a crime in progress, call 911.

ABANDONED VEHICLES

 Abandoned Vehicles include cars and RVs that have been deserted, lack a license plate, have expired or altered registration or appear to be inoperative or wrecked.

• Most common:

- Debris, garbage & junk
- Overgrown vegetation
- Private property parking
- Graffiti
- Sidewalk trip hazards







DEVELOPMENT CODE CASES

- MOST COMMON VIOLATIONS:
 - Trees, development without a permit (including environmental overlays)
- CODE COMPLIANCE'S ROLE:
 - Inspect the property to document violations and enforce on behalf of Urban Design & Planning (UDP)
- PROCESS
 - Code collaborates with the Planner on Duty (POD) to manage the case
 - POD confirms the violations, provides instructions for resolving the violation
- TREE CODE VIOLATION PROCESS
 - Holding tree removal companies responsible for violations
 - Enforcement process improvements
